God Gave Us The Pattern By Charles Box

The Almighty God is a very organized and orderly being. He has always done things in a systematic way. "God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints." (1 Corinthians 14:53) Concerning patterns we know that God has never left man to his own ways. He has always told him what he must do to be accepted of Him. Moses and the tabernacle is an example of how God gave patterns. God gave Moses a pattern for the tabernacle. "Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, that thou make all things according to the pattern showed to thee in the mount." (Hebrews 8:5) Moses was admonished to build by God's pattern. We must likewise follow God's pattern and not go beyond those things that are written. (1 Corinthians 4:6)

God gave Noah a very specific pattern when he was to build an ark. He said, "Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch. And this is the fashion which thou shalt make it of: The length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits, the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits. A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; with lower, second, and third stories shalt thou make it." (Genesis 6:14-16) The fashion or shape and design of the ark was very clear to Noah even before he started to build. We are accustomed to using patterns, blueprints, and recipes. We must discipline ourselves to follow God's patterns in all things. Everything we teach and practice in our Christianity must be done in the name of or by the authority of Jesus Christ. "And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him." (Colossians 3:17) Our doctrine must strictly be the doctrine of Jesus Christ. Paul admonished us to "Hold fast the form (or pattern) of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, faith and love which is in Christ Jesus." (2 Timothy 1:13) It is impossible to hold to a form or pattern that is constantly changing.

The New Testament is God's permanent or fixed pattern for the entire Christian age. Jesus said, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen." (Matthew 28:19-20) Let us hold fast to the sound, incorruptible words of the gospel.

God gave us the pattern for salvation. Salvation is by the blood of Jesus Christ. He said, "For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins." (Matthew 26:28) Salvation is "in Christ." "Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sake, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory." (2 Timothy 2:10) To get into Christ one must hear the gospel (Romans 10:17), believe in Jesus (John 8:24), repent of sins (Luke 13:3), confess faith in Christ (Romans 10:10), and be baptized into Christ for the remission of sins. (Acts 2:38) This is God's pattern and salvation is available through no other means.

God gave us a pattern for the church. God's pattern for the church shows its singular nature. Jesus said to Peter, "I say also unto thee, That thou are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." (Matthew 16:18) Jesus Christ promised to build his "Church" not "Churches". Notice the expressions "the church" and "it" in Ephesians 5:25-27. "Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word. That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish."

God gave us the pattern for church organization. The Scripture provides specific qualifications for elders or bishops and deacons. (Titus 1, 1 Timothy 3) The church at Philippi had bishops or elders and it had deacons along with the members. "paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons." (Philippians 1:1) Godly and scripturally qualified leadership fits God's pattern.

God Gave us the pattern for church worship. The message of the Bible is "worship God!" (Revelation 22:9) On "the first day of the week" the church is to worship by God's pattern. There will be prayers led by godly men. (Acts 2:42) There will be generous giving. (1 Corinthians 16:1-2) This giving will be proportional giving and will be cheerfully done. Singing, without mechanical

instruments, making melody in the heart is authorized by God. (Ephesians 5:19) God's pattern also includes preaching or teaching the gospel. (Acts 2:42) The Lord's Supper is observed every Sunday. (Matthew 26:26-30, 1 Corinthians 11:17-29)

God gave us the pattern which made the church of Christ distinct. The church was (1) Founded by Christ (Matthew 16:18), (2) There is one church (Ephesians 4:4), (3) The saved are added to the church (Acts 2:47), and (4) The people of God are to be united in the one church. (1 Corinthians 1:10; John 17:20-23) The pattern also includes the following:

- The right beginning time: the first Pentecost after Christ's resurrection. (Acts 2:1)
- 2. The right beginning place: the city of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 2:1-3)
- 3. The right Head: Jesus Christ (Colossians 1:18)
- 4. The right name for members: Christians. (Acts 11:26)
- 5. The right name or names for the church: churches of Christ (Romans 16:16), church of God. (1 Corinthians 1:2) There were also other descriptive terms showing the church in its relationship with Christ.
- 6. The right foundation: Jesus Himself. (Ephesians 2:20)
- 7. The right headquarters: Heaven. (Acts 2:33)
- 8. The right guide book: The Bible. (1 Peter 4:11)
- 9. The right mission: Soul-saving. (Matthew 28:19-20)
- 10. The right destination: Heaven. (1 Corinthians 15:24)

The church was planned by the mind of Almighty God. "And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ: To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God, According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Ephesians 3:9-11) We only have His church when we follow His pattern. Why not be a member of Christ's church, be faithful and go to heaven when this life ends?
