What is your hope and aspiration for this New Year? What can be done to make it great? Are you willing to work at it?

2012 can be great if you become a Christian. "How shall we escape, if we neglect so GREAT salvation" (Hebrews 2:3)? Three times in the reading of Luke fifteen the word lost is used.
