The Way of the Transgressor Is...

Most would be able to finish quoting this passage. It is found in Proverbs 13:15. "Good understanding giveth favour; but the way of the transgressor is hard." A transgressor is one who is guilty of sin. John writes, "Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law; for sin is the transgression of the law" (1 John 3:4). God's word declares that sin is a hard road to travel. Proverbs 23:29:31 describes the sin of consuming alcohol. Is the way of the drinker hard? Yes, it is.

First, it is hard on the body. Most people who drink would say that they do it to feel better. However, alcohol is not a stimulant but a depressant. It does the opposite of what they desire. The consumption of alcohol is hard on the physiology of the body. Micheale Dunlap, a clinical psychologist, has written an article (<http://www.oregoncounseling.org/ArticlesPapers/Documents/ETOHBIOfx.htm>) about alcohol and its effect on the body. From this paper it is evident that alcohol is hard on the liver, the central nervous system, blood, gastrointestinal system, muscles and endocrine system. People, who drink, even socially, think that they are doing no harm to their body. The child of God must remember that he is to do nothing which will harm his body. "What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's" (1 Corinthians 6:19, 20). Regretfully, many find out the hard effects of alcohol on their body when it is too late. Let us teach our children, and show by our example, that alcohol should never touch their lips.

Second, alcohol is hard because of its ability to strip. Certain alcohols are used to remove unwanted paint on furniture. Alcohol that is meant to be consumed is a remover as well. It removes inhibition. Listen to country, rock or any type of music and you will see the removing effect of alcohol (a country song has the words: Tequila makes her clothes fall off). Drinking led to Noah's children looking upon his nakedness (Genesis 9:18-23). Alcohol removed Lot's sense of fatherhood (Genesis 19:30-38). How often has alcohol stripped a person of their dignity? Commercials depict that alcohol offers one a taste of the good life. However, they don't show you the person wallowing in their own vomit. How many parents have been removed from their children because a person decided to drive while under the influence of alcohol? Alcohol related deaths are in the tens of thousands! How many have been removed from their jobs because of alcohol. Have you heard about the repeated news reports about the boozing during lunch breaks by the auto workers in Detroit? Brethren, may we never be fooled by the devil when it comes to the use of alcohol. Too many things are removed by alcohol!

Finally and most importantly, alcohol is hard because sin will cause us to be lost eternally. Paul says that the sin of drunkenness will cause one not to enter heaven (Galatian 5:19-21). The first drink of alcohol begins to have an effect. Many are willing to risk the pleasure of drinking alcohol at the expense of eternity (Hebrews 11:25). To the

Corinthians (1 Corinthians 6:9-11) Paul said that the unrighteous would not inherit the kingdom of God. One of those unrighteous acts involved being drunk. Paul says that is what some of them used to be, but no longer. If someone has been a drunk is it okay for them to drink a little. All alcohol recovery programs say that one must stop completely or else risk a relapse. One will never become a drunk without taking the first drink. Too many have thought they could handle their liquor only to learn it is a terrible master (Romans 6:12). Are you willing to lose your soul (Matthew 16:26) in order to gain the appeal of the world (Galatians 1:10)?

Yes, sin makes the life of the transgressor hard but Jesus is here to make life easier (John 10:10; Matthew 11:28-30). If you will give your life to Christ through obedience (faith, repentance, confession of Jesus and baptism) to the gospel (1 Peter 1:22) you can be saved. Are you living faithfully (Revelation 2:10) to Jesus? Make your life right with God so that heaven can be your eternal home.
